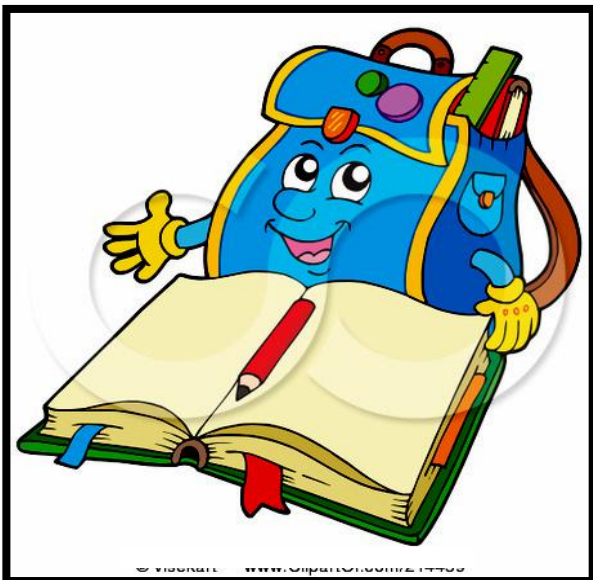

Learnt many new things and had so much fun.

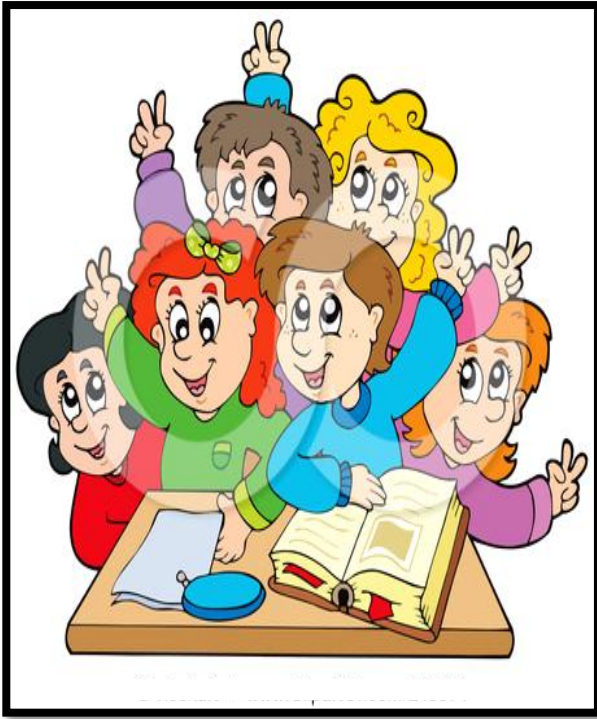
I want to share with you and everyone.

My teacher taught us the number name 'eight'.

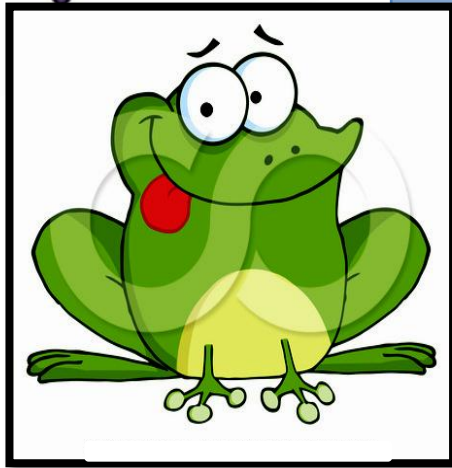
I am thorough with the numbers till 50. I have moved ahead to numbers 51-60.

"Cleanliness" is the virtue I have learnt!

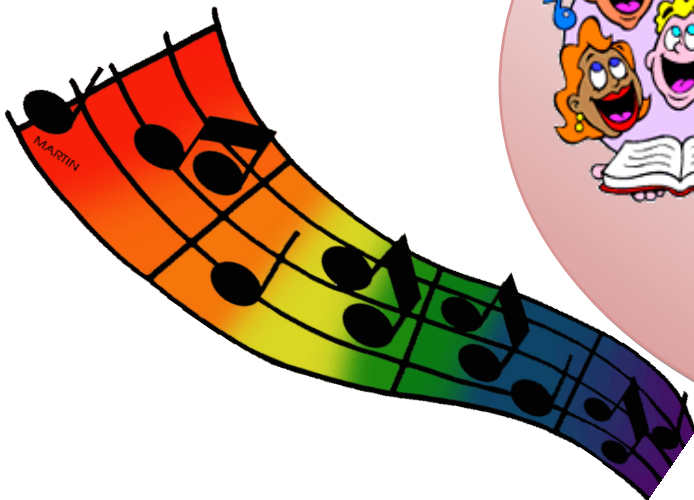
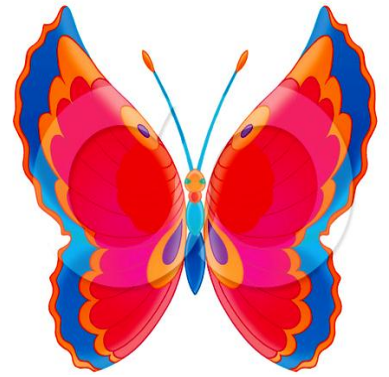




ART

MUSIC

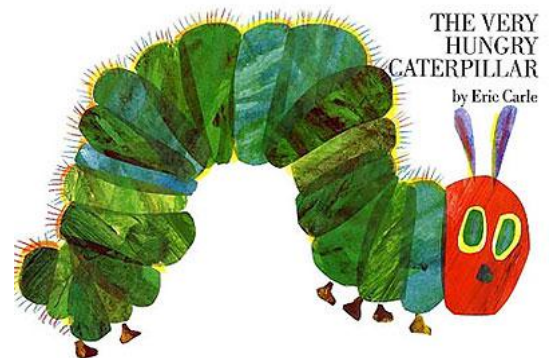
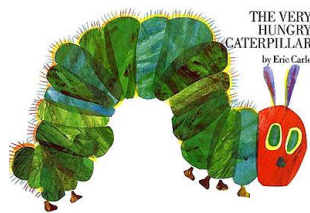
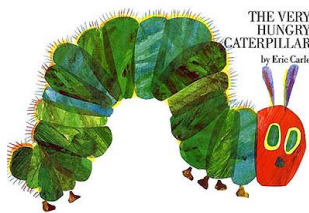

I can sing. So much joy music can bring!



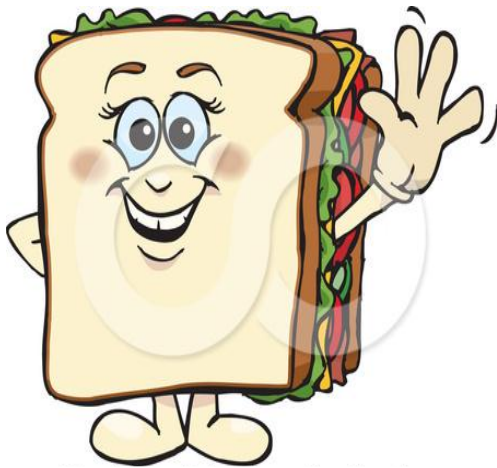


The children of kindergarten 2 put up a Special Assembly depicting the life cycle of a butterfly in the form of a story "The very hungry caterpillar".

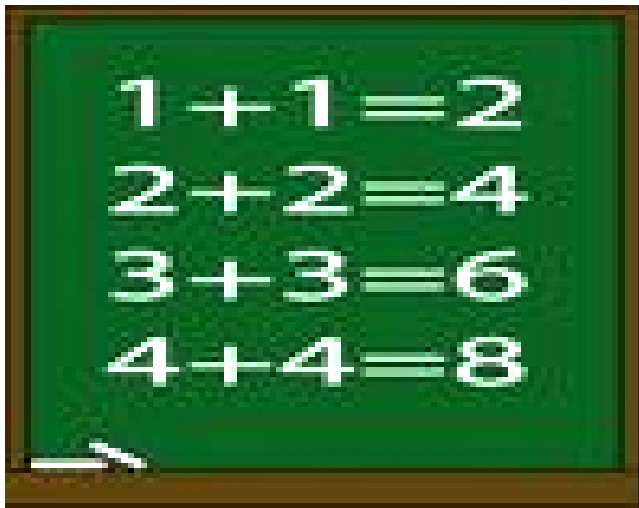


Diwali Celebration- Diwali celebration was joy and fun. Music and dance we enjoyed. We shared our snacks.

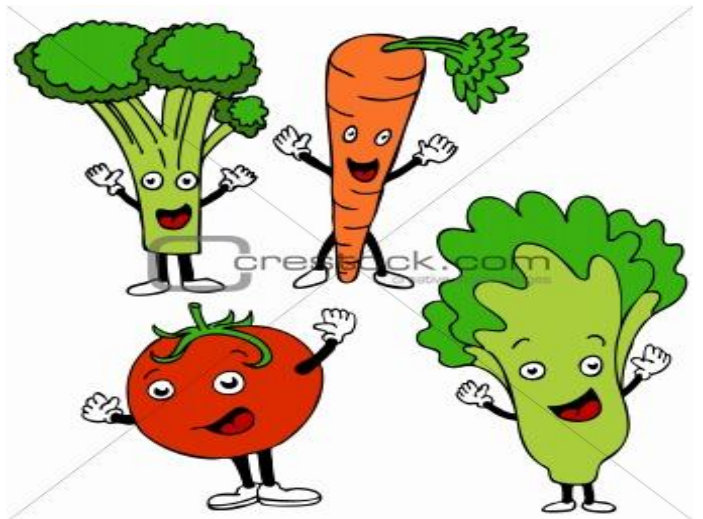


These are some of the activities which you can enjoy doing at home with your child
