These are some of the activities which you can enjoy doing at home with your child

Help your child to shrug off shyness

Playing with friends is an important way for children to learn social rules such as sharing and taking turns. The key is taking small and gentle steps that encourage positive social interaction without being too pushy. Your child may be shy or cautious by nature, and this isn't necessarily a bad thing. Rather than try to change your child's personality, you can help him stretch just enough to discover the joys of relationships with peers.



Cultivate Reading Habit

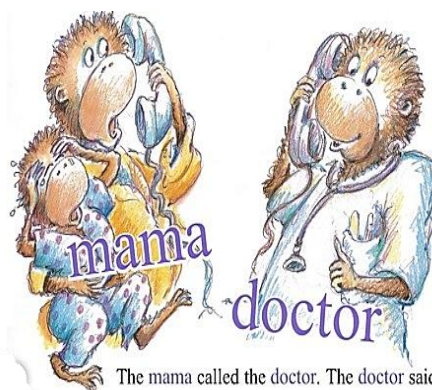
Heard of audio books? **Make your own!** Read a book with your child into an audio recorder. Let your child add sound effects (using pots and pans, any musical instrument, utensils, anything that makes noise) or read a couple of lines of the book. If it's a favorite your child has memorized, let him read part or all of the book into the recorder. Let your child play the recording back and read along.

Go on a Number Safari

When you're driving around town, have your child look for numbers in street and store signs, and license plates. Call out the numbers as you find them. Being able to recognize numbers up to 20 is an important skill at this age.

Any variation on this counting rhyme introduces basic subtraction. Look for children's games and music activity tapes such as the *Wee Sing* series that features songs about numbers.
