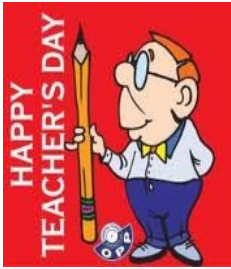
- Quran Recitation Competition on 27th September
